

REGULAR MEETING OF THE TOWN OF PLEVNA-Monday, July 11, 2022, 7:00 p.m.
Plevna Community Center

Mayor Thielen called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.

Councilmen present: Kyle Vennes, James Franson, Alba Higgins, and Jordan Hoffman

The minutes were approved for the June 13, 2022 meeting.

Public Comment:

- No public comment

Correspondence:

- G&G Garbage sent a letter stating there would be a rate increase
- Denning, Downey and Associates sent a proposal for the upcoming financial review.
- Pace sent a quote for camera/cleaning the sewer lines
- Jordan Hoffman sent a letter of resignation from the Council.

Old Business:

- **Bohle Water Line** – Mylan Bohle will bore under the highway to hook into the main water line. Bobby Wiedmer will do the digging work for the well/meter pit. The Town will need to let Bobby know the requirements for depth etc. Mylan Bohle will be responsible for getting the required permits. Rick will need to mark the water main.
- **FWD parts** – This has been put on the back burner for the summer.
- **Budget Prep** – Jolene will get Krista to come in and help with doing the budget.
- **Mowing the Lagoon** – Rick talked to the Fire Dept. and they will burn around the lagoon as a training exercise. Rick will rent a mower and mow the lagoon and the bulk water site by the end of July.
- **Raise sewer rates** – Bobbie Schueler came down and went through the system. She had a spreadsheet that calculated the estimated values based on water line size. The council reviewed the spreadsheet and thought it would be best to see what the G&G Garbage rate increase would be before moving forward. They are not sure at this point if the G&G rate increase will impact the garbage rates.

New Business:

- Appointment of Planning Board member –

A motion was made by Councilman Higgins, seconded by Councilman Vennes to order a sign saying no bikes, mopeds, or motorcycles in the park.
