

REGULAR MEETING OF THE TOWN OF PLEVNA – Monday, June 12, 2017, 7:00 p.m.

Town of Plevna Office

Mayor Benner called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Councilmen present were Gary Thielen, Shawn Sander and Alba Higgins. T.C. Shelhamer was absent.

Also present was Corrine Sanders, wastewater operator and Mark Thielen, container site operator.

Members of the public present: Henry Hastig IV

The minutes of the May 8, 2017 meeting were read and approved with one correction.

Public comment – Henry Hastig IV indicated that the diversion of water off of 2nd St is causing water to enter his garage. The council discussed the issue and a culvert will be installed in the alley and in Henry's driveway.

Henry left the meeting.

Correspondence – the town limit map that was submitted by Forrest Sanderson was examined by the council. This map was drawn using the coordinates given in the original request for incorporation presented to Fallon County in 1916.

Old Business

Street Resurface – the streets will be resurfaced the week of July 10th. The clerk will contact Mike Sharp with Prince again to ensure the chips are delivered prior to that date. Dale Butori and Alba will spray weeds and grass along the streets. Ten to twelve loads of gravel will be brought in the end of June to finish the street prep. All the valve boxes will need to be marked and uncovered again. Gary will contact Bob's Tree Service about the branches and trees that will need to be removed prior to the project. The clerk will post notices and send out a notice in the June water bill that all vehicles must be removed from the town right of way prior to July 10th, advising house windows to be closed during the project and asking property owners to mow the town right of way bordering their property.

The clerk will send letters to Misty Radue, the Estate of Fuzz Ehret, Mark Branson and Tyler Medearis requesting their yards be mowed prior to June 30th or the Town will hire it done and the property owner will be charged.

Department Reports

- Container site operator – Mark sprayed weeds at the dump site
- Water operator – no report
- Sewer operator – Corrine met with the DEQ and an Operations and Maintenance Inspection of the wastewater system was completed.

The inspector recommended that the fence on the south side of the lagoon be repaired and that record keeping of the inspections and maintenance completed on the lagoon be implemented. He also advised that horses not be allowed to graze until the vegetation along the lagoon edge is cut to allow observation/determination whether banks are eroding.

Council/Mayor Comments

Alba stated there has been garbage stacked on the compactor outside of container site hours.

Gary has observed a pig being kept in a residential area.
