

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE TOWN COUNCIL – Friday, September 20, 2019, 7:00 pm.

Mayor Willie Benner called the meeting to order 7:02 p.m.

Councilmen present were Alba Higgins, Kyle Vennes, Gary Thielen, and arriving later Jordan Hoffman

- The council reviewed the prepared Public Notice for a raise in all utility rates. There was one error found and a correction was made. The Public Notice will be posted on Monday, September 23<sup>rd</sup>, for three consecutive weeks, in three previously designated public places. A Public Notice mailing will also be sent out at least 7 days prior to the public hearing date.

**A motion was made by Councilman Higgins, seconded by Councilman Thielen to adopt Resolution #165, a Resolution of Intention of the Town of Plevna, to Increase the Rates for Users of the Municipal Water, Wastewater, and Garbage Systems.**

- Councilman Higgins and Councilman Vennes signed off on adding Gary Thielen and Krista Nemitz to The Bank of Baker signature card as discussed at the previous meeting.
- Councilman Higgins brought information of a closed cab tractor that will be stored in the Senior Center Storage Building for using to sweep snow off the sidewalks this winter.
- Rachael Brockel of Rachael's Accounting is willing to complete the Town's Annual Financial Report for \$500.
- It was suggested that the Town gather bids for having the sidewalks on Main Street repaired. Another suggestion was made to spread scoria in a few of the alleys that need maintenance.
